**THE SUBURBAN HOUSTON ~ FORT BEND ALUMNAE CHAPTER HAS BEEN SERVING MISSOURI CITY & FORT BEND COUNTY SINCE 1976!**

In the latter part of 1975, Sorors in the Houston area formed a coalition to develop plans to serve the citizens of Fort Bend County. This group contacted the national office to secure information on how this goal could be accomplished. A committee was established to conduct a feasibility study and draft the chartering document. The regional director, Soror Eula Butler, who resided in the area, was instrumental in guiding the group in completing the necessary tasks to submit the chartering request.

The efforts of these women were well received by the national office and the chartering occurred on May 22, 1976. It was during the regional convention held in Little Rock, Arkansas in 1976, that Soror Butler announced the Missouri City ~ Fort Bend Alumnae Chapter (its chartering name), as a new member of the Delta

family under the leadership of Rosalie Johnson Buggs.

In 1978, the name was changed to the Suburban Houston ~ Fort Bend Alumnae Chapter.

**DUES INFORMATION**

**Sisterhood Scholarship Service**

We are currently in the 2016/2017 sorority year which began July 1, 2016 and will end June 30, 2017.

Golden Life and Diamond Life Paid-In-Full Members do not pay National dues, Reinstatement, or Late fees.

Local dues must be paid via cash, check, or money order.

All forms of payments are accepted for National Dues (i.e. personal checks, cashier's checks, money orders, and/or credit cards).

If you were a 2015/2016 member & did not pay your 2016/2017 dues by June 30th, a \$15 reinstatement fee is required. A \$25 reinstatement fee is required if you have not been a member of any chapter for two or more fiscal years.

If you are a Member-at-Large changing to a Regular Member, a \$25 category change fee is required.

The March Chapter meeting is the last day that checks will be accepted for the payment of dues for the 2017/2018 sorority year for submission by the March 31, 2017 deadline. Dues payments made after the March meeting may require additional fees due to payment type & date payment is made.

Dues can be paid during chapter and/or executive board meetings. Checks and/or money orders should be made payable to Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. Members can also send dues payments to the Chapter's P.O. Box.
